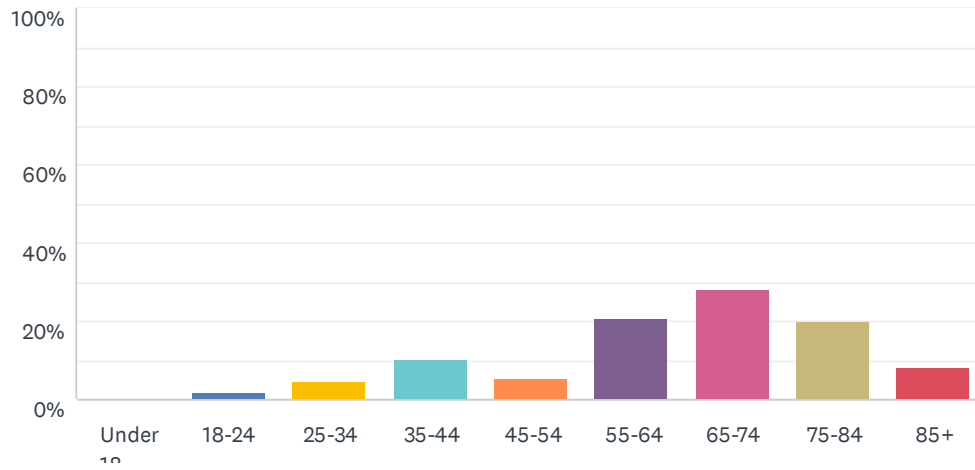

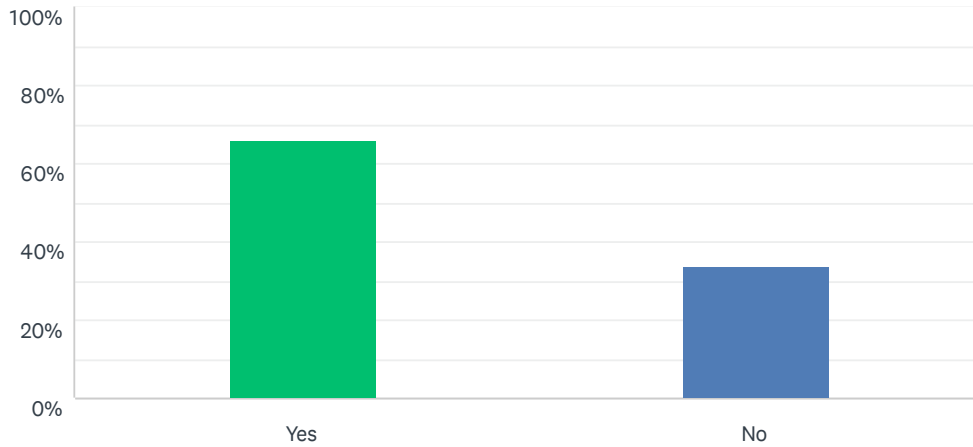

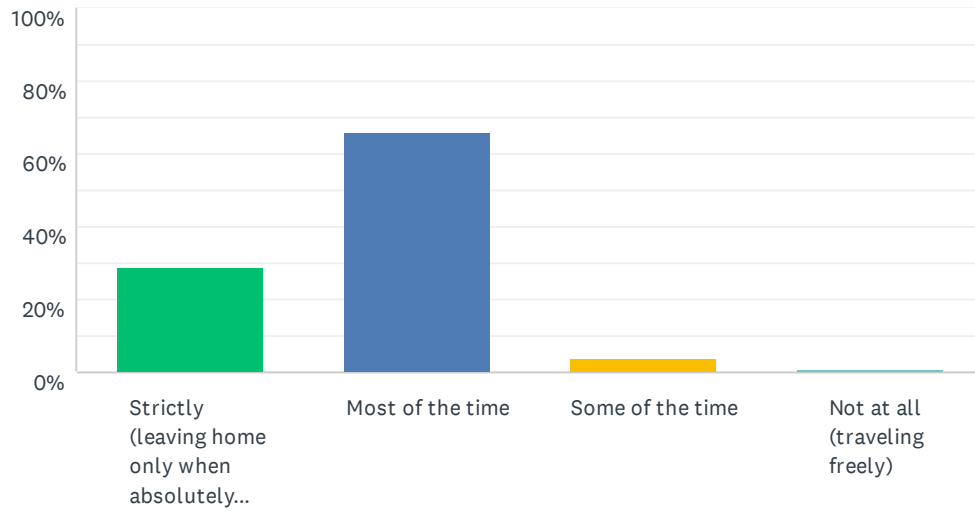

Q3 How strictly have you complied with the "Stay-At-Home" orders?

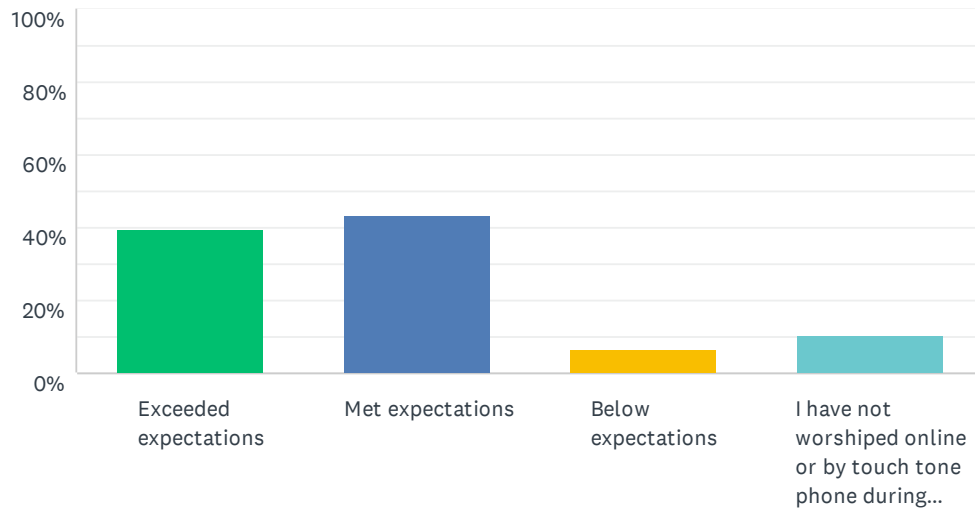

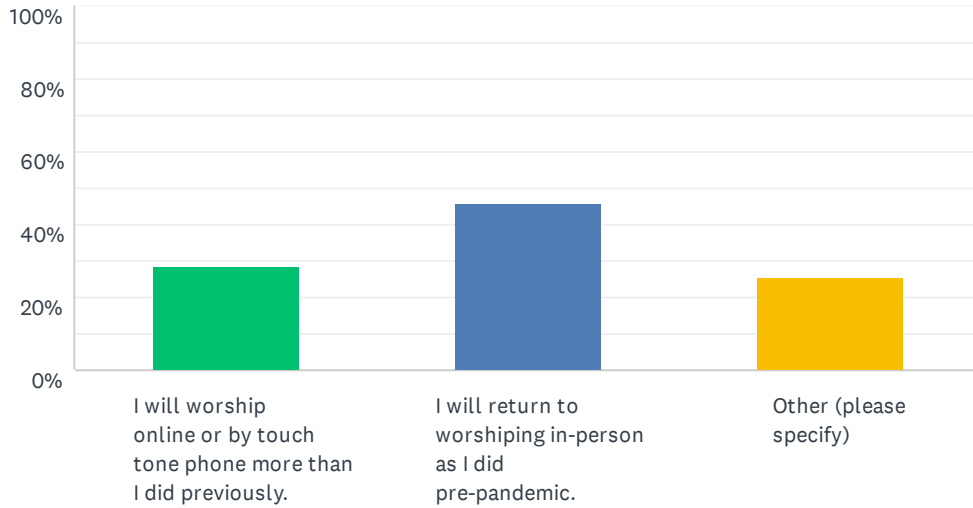

Q7 After this time of social/physical distancing and online worship, what do you think will be your pattern of worship participation for the foreseeable future?

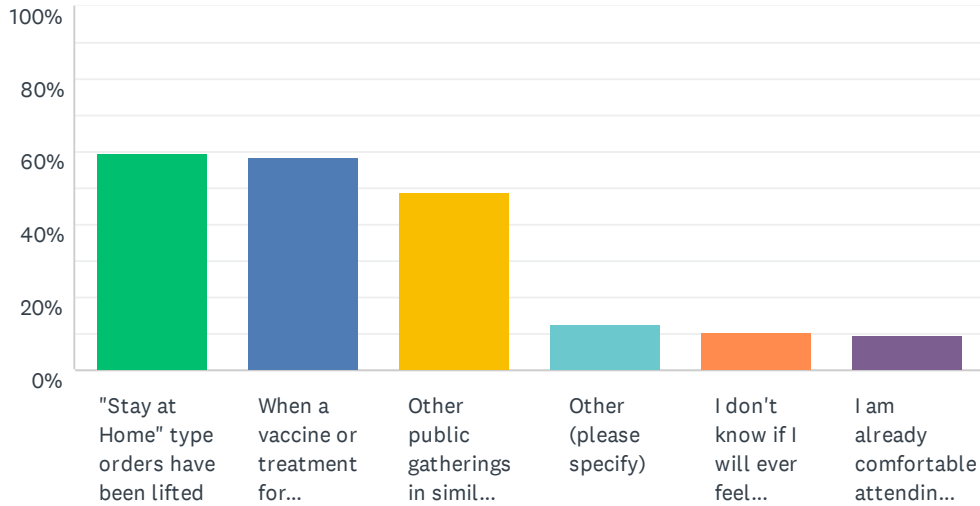

Q8 Given your current understanding of the spread of coronavirus and cases of COVID-19, which of the following is necessary for you to attend an in-person worship service? (check all that apply)

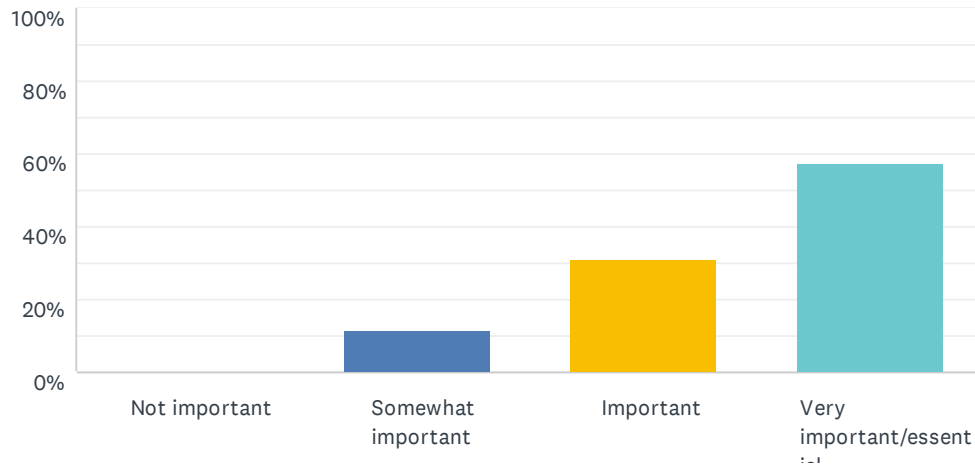

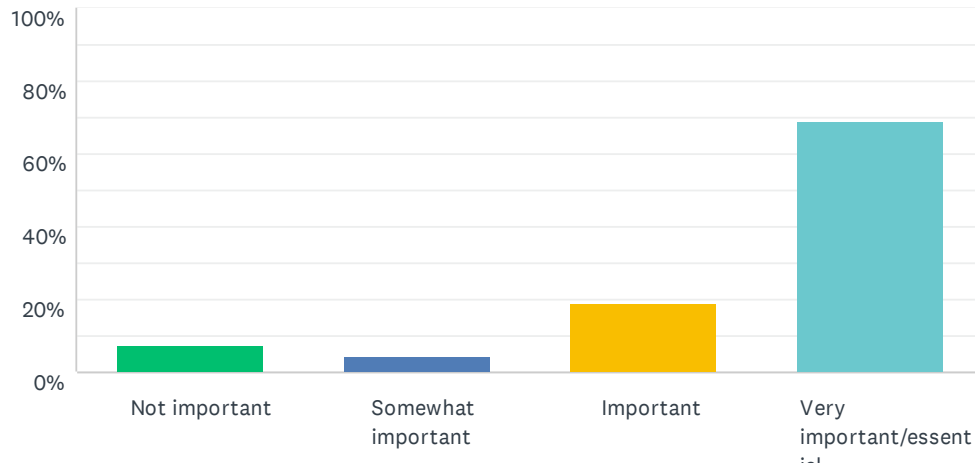

Q10 Greeters not shaking hands?

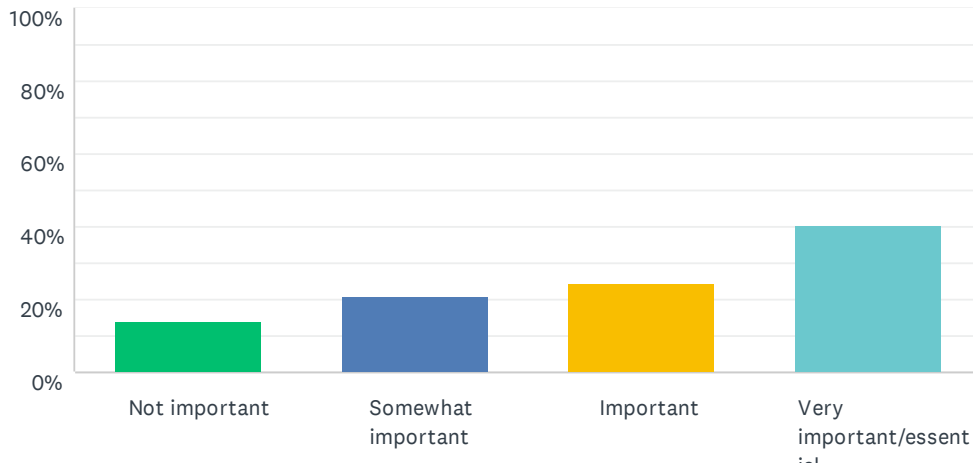

Q11 No receiving line with the pastor or preacher of the day?

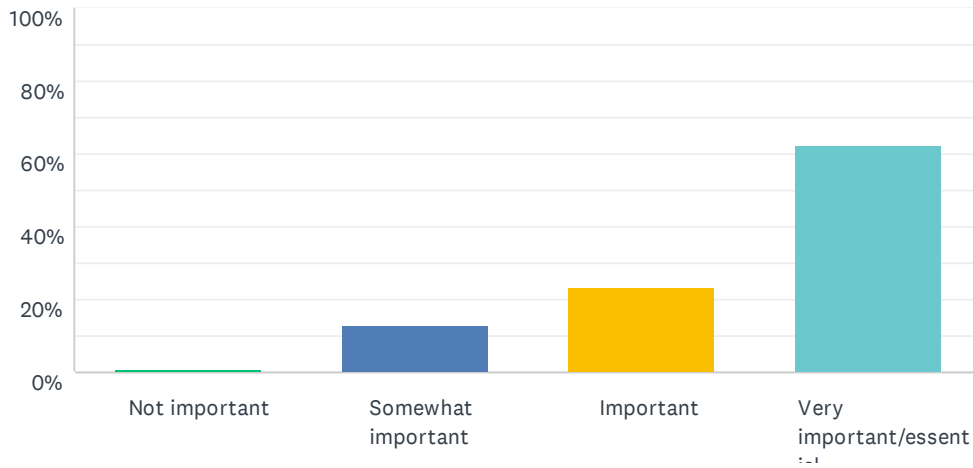

Q12 Masks required for in-person worship participants?

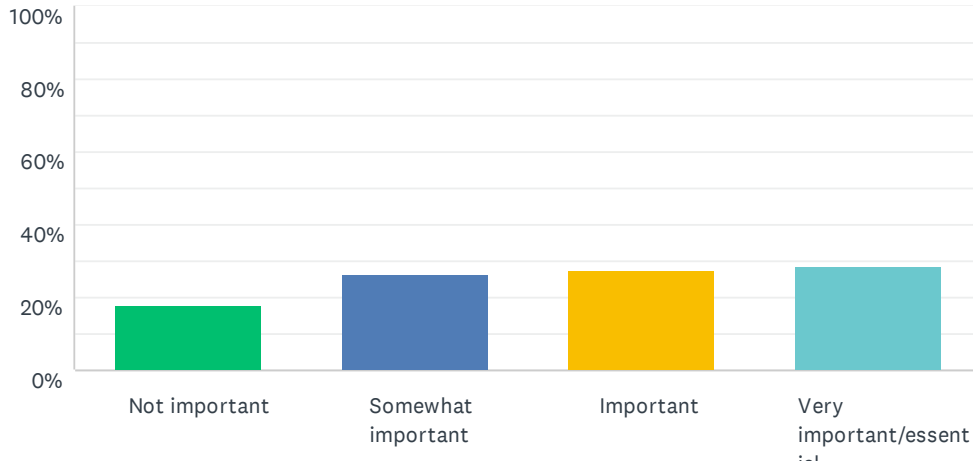

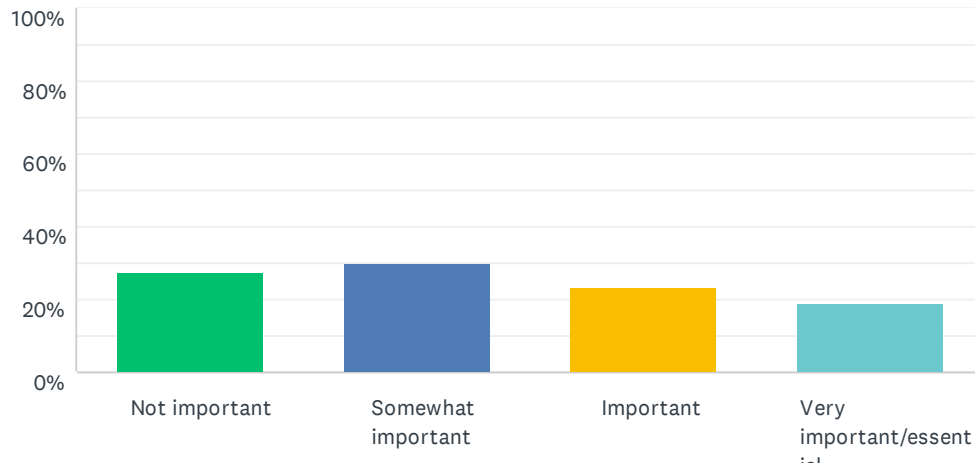

Q14 No paper (including no bulletins) distributed by any method?

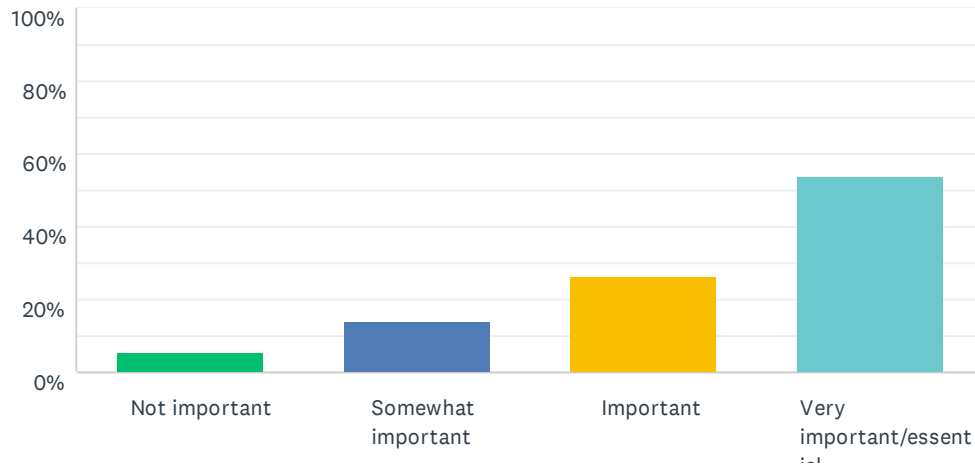

Q15 Communion elements not offered by typical method?

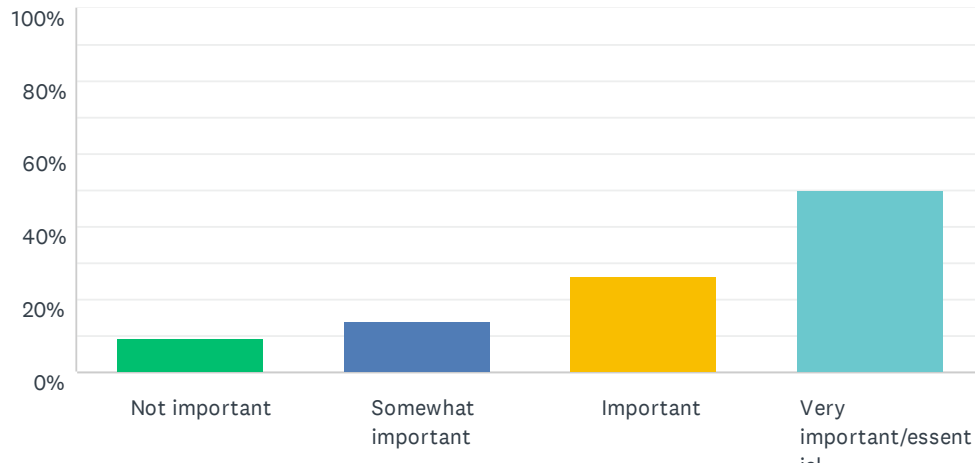

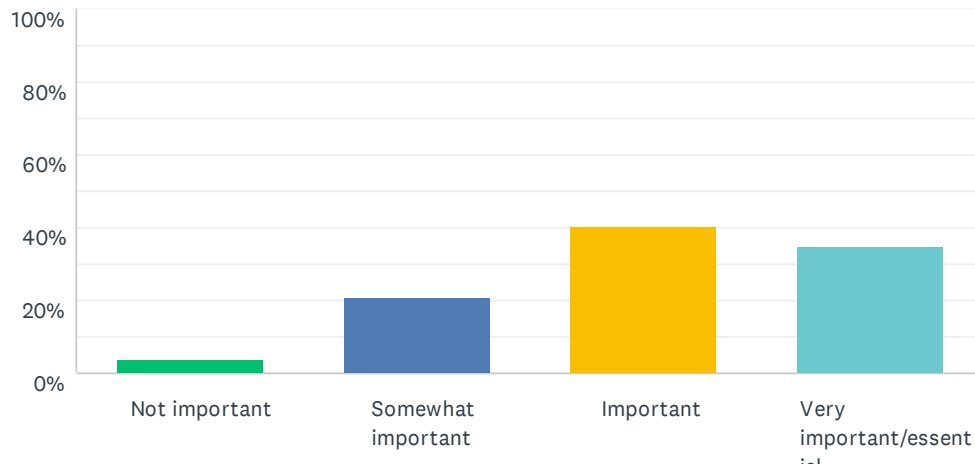

Q17 Phased exiting of the worship space and building (leaving gradually, without crowding)?

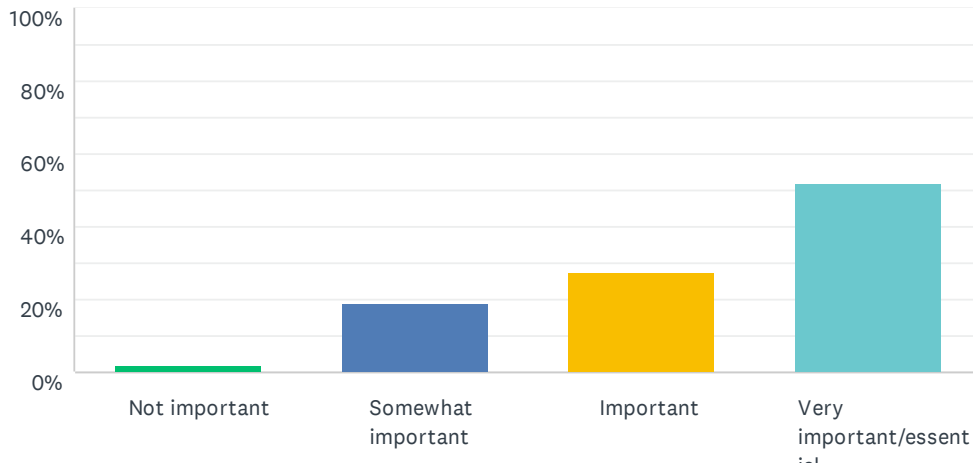

Q18 Hard surfaces wiped down between worship services or gatherings?

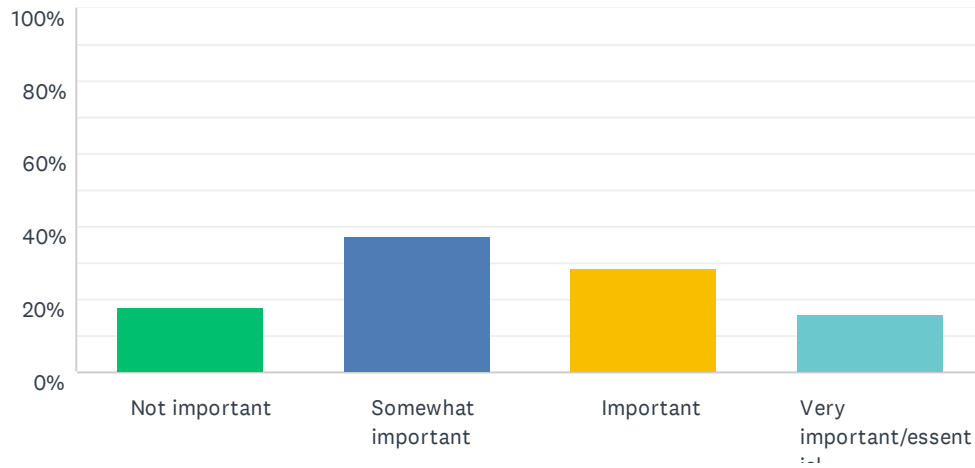

Q19 Temperature checks for everyone upon entry?

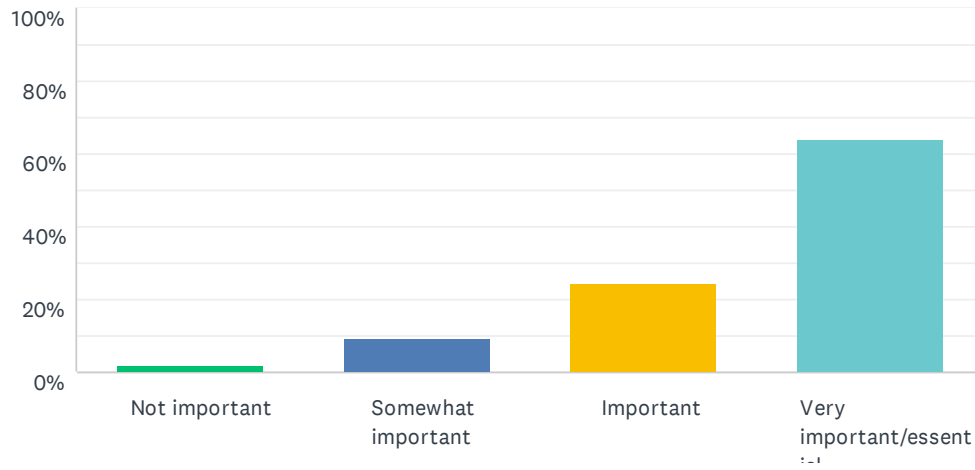

Q20 Hand sanitizer available at entrances/exits?

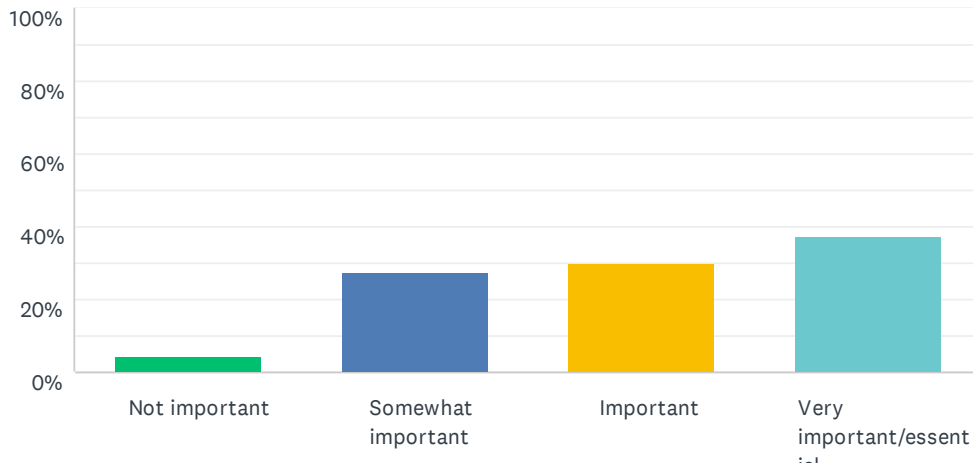

Q21 Prop doors open to avoid touching handles?

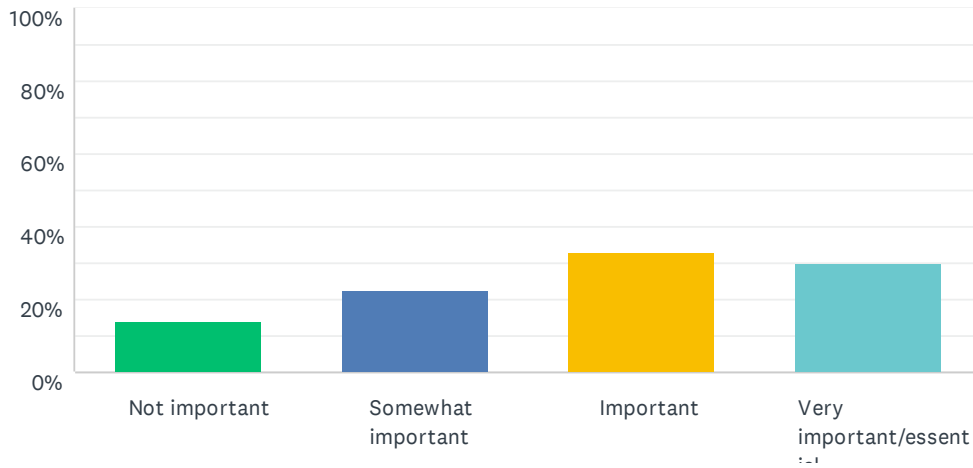

Q22 Set up one-way foot traffic for entering and exiting the sanctuary?

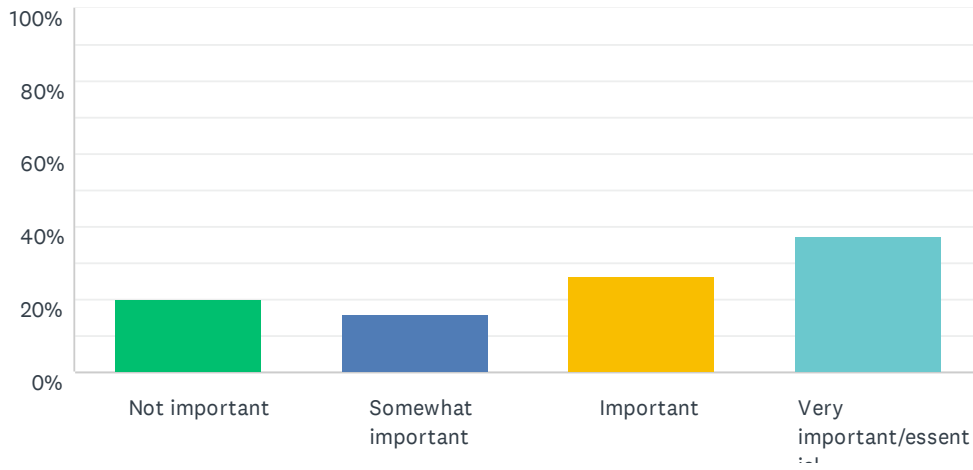

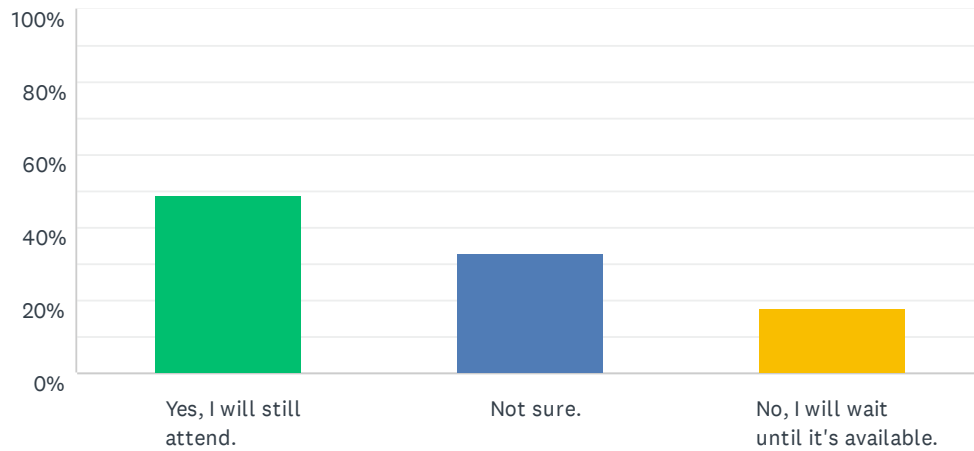

Q24 Would you still be interested in attending in-person worship with the following precaution in place: no singing?

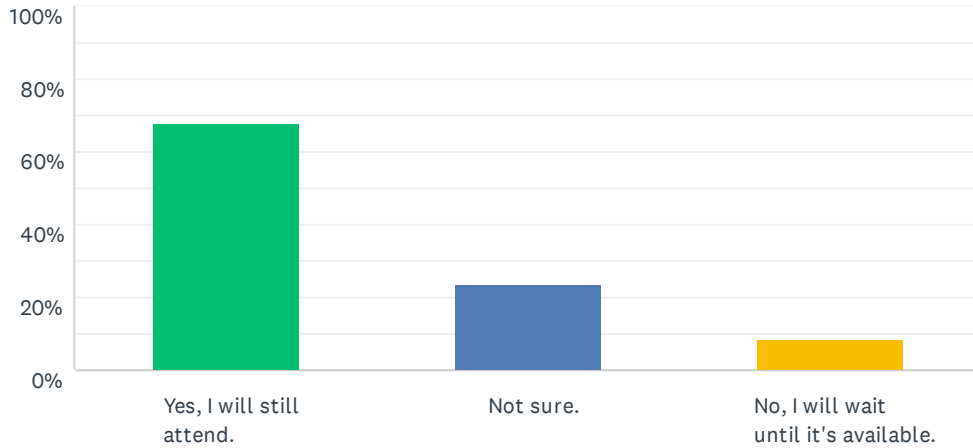

Q25 Would you still be interested in attending in-person with the following precaution in place: no nursery care or Sunday School classes for children or adults?

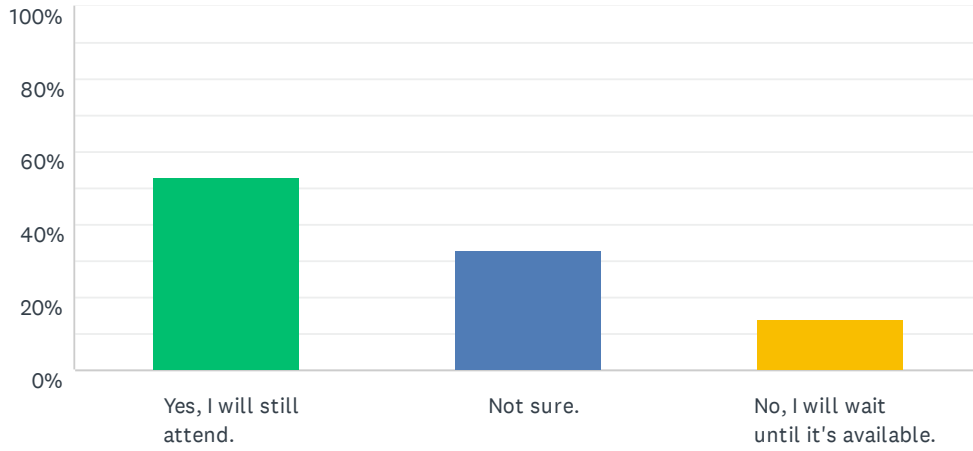

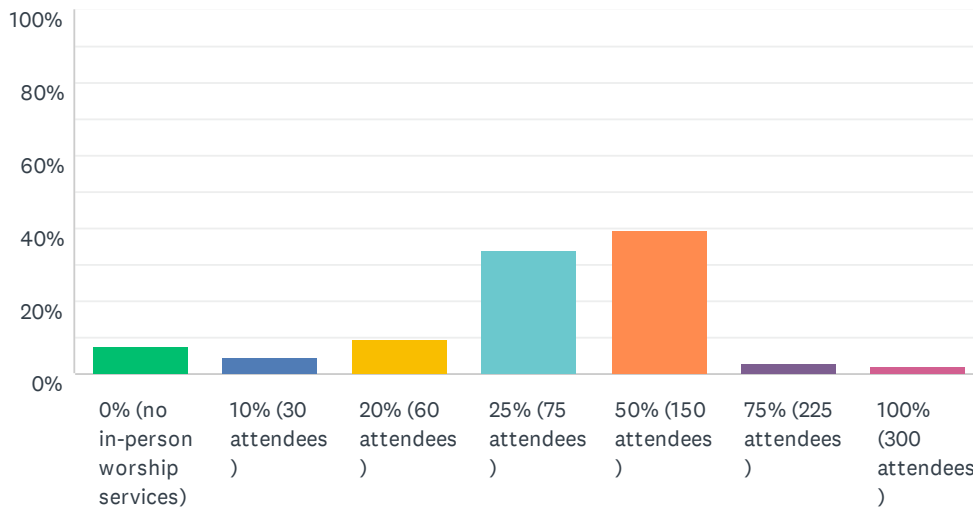

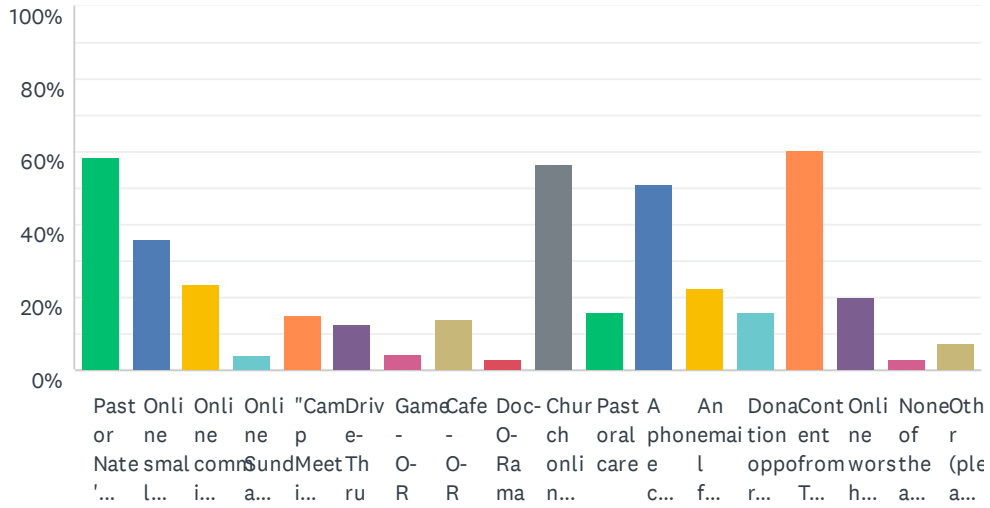

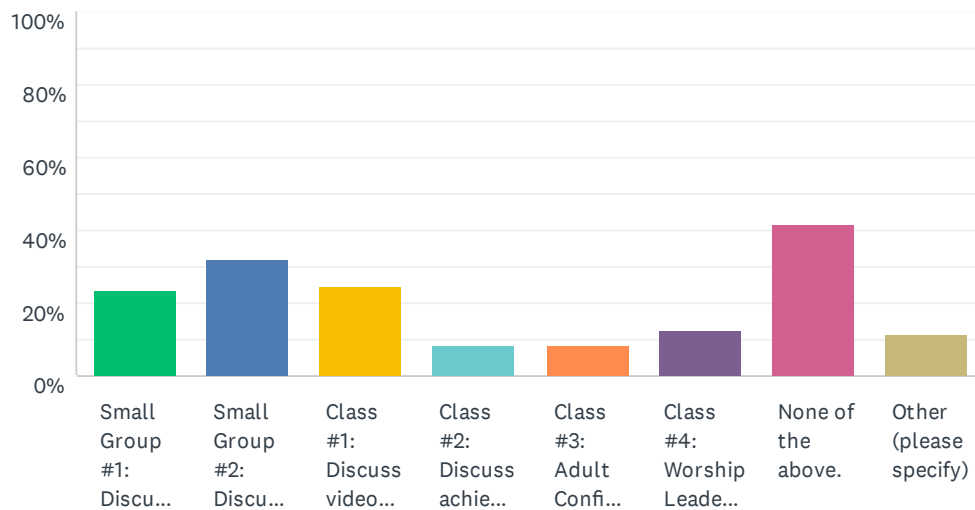

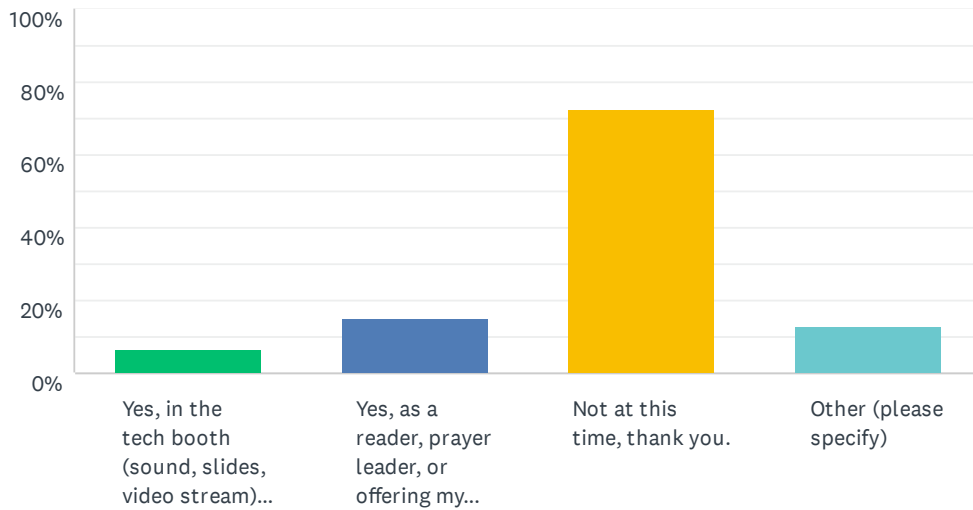
