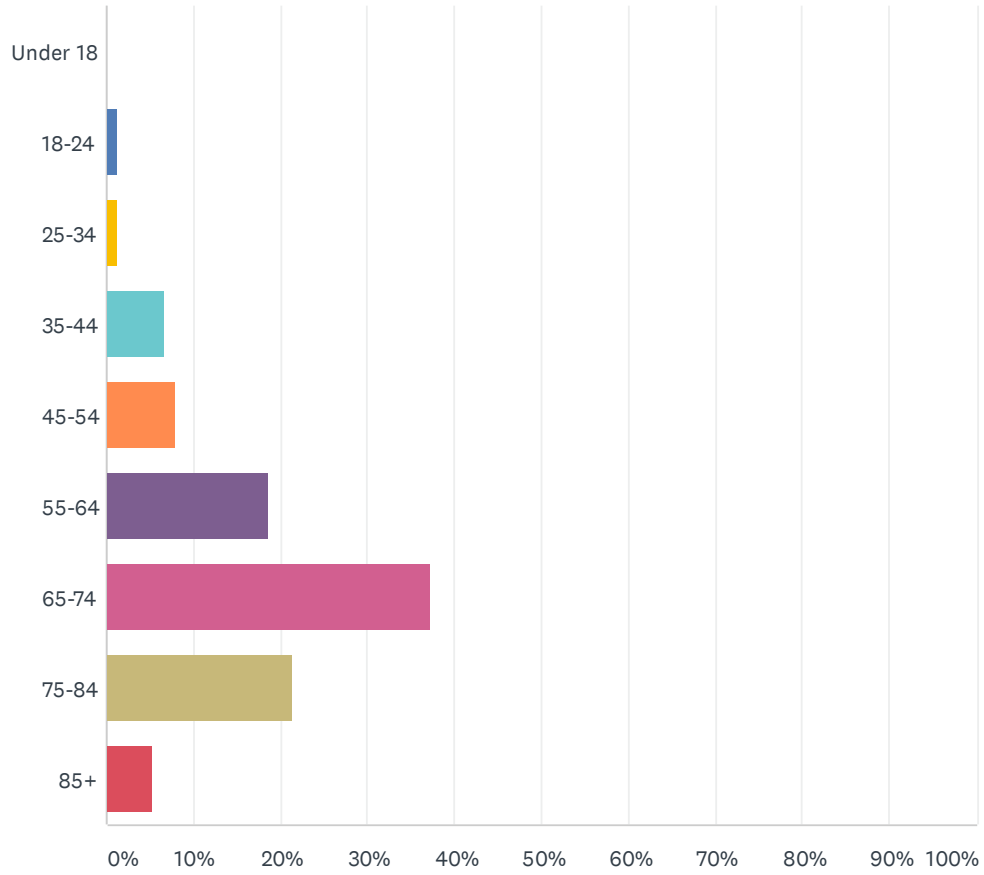


# Q1 What is your age?

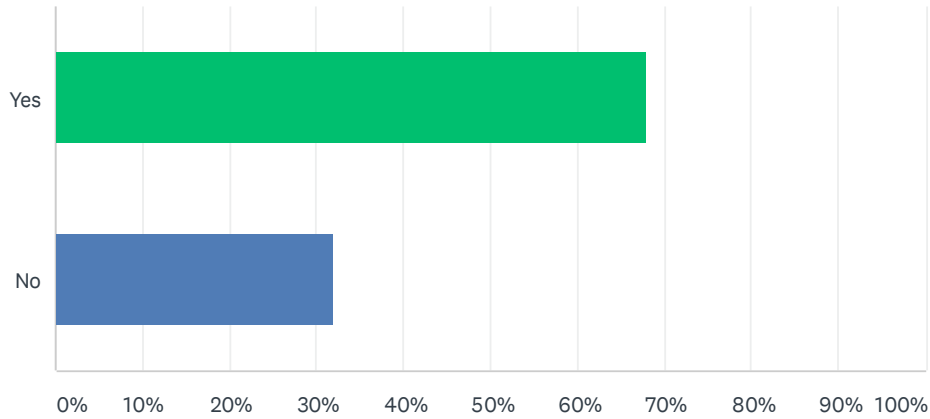

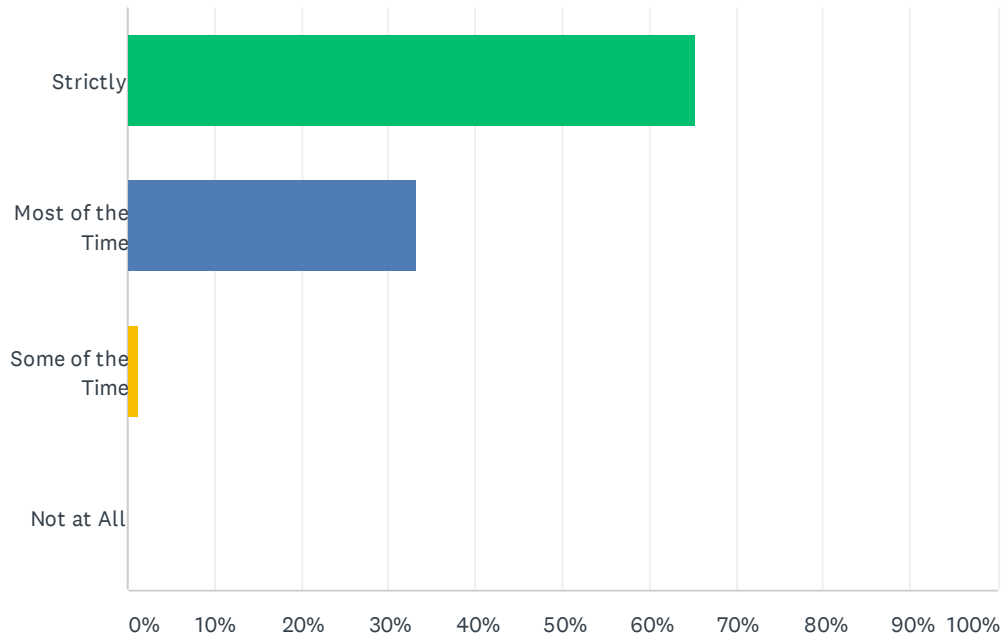

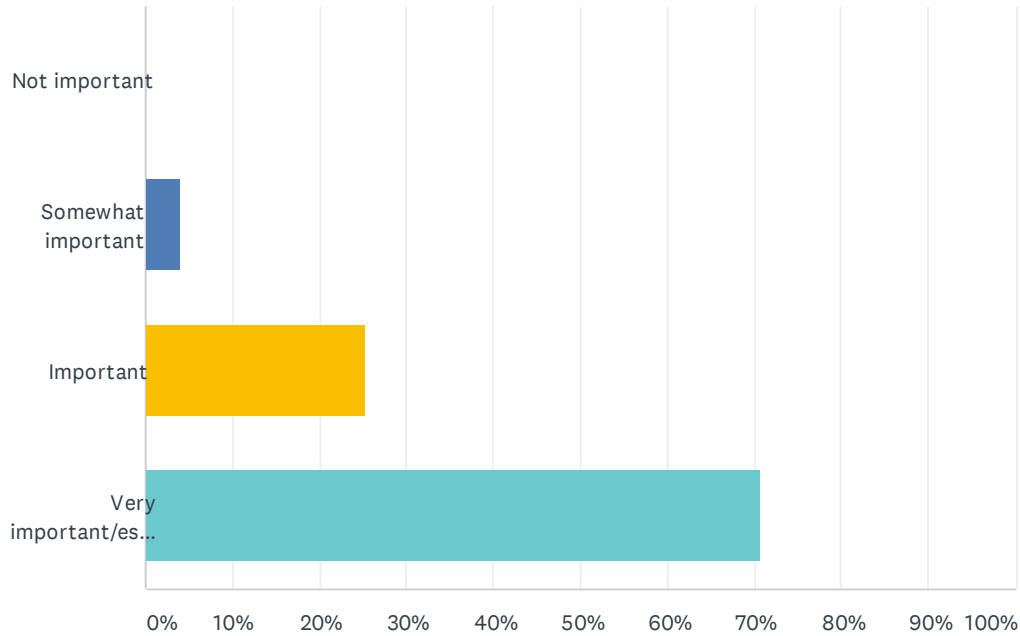

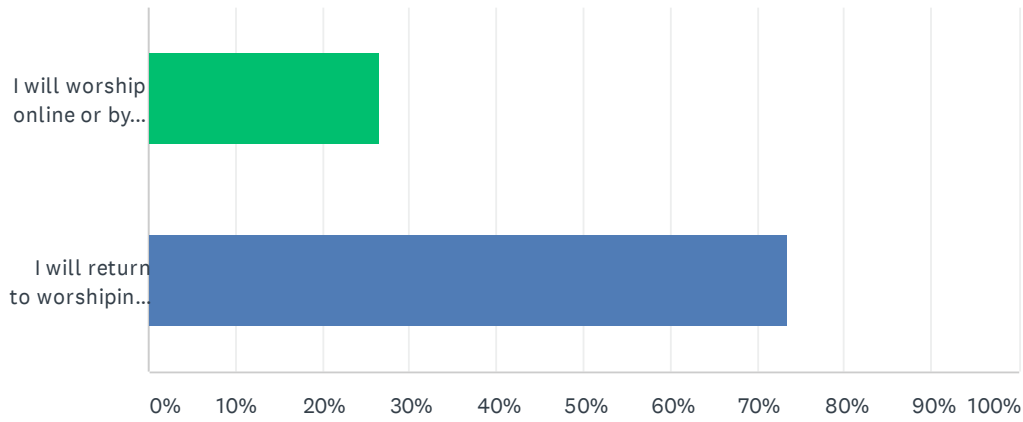

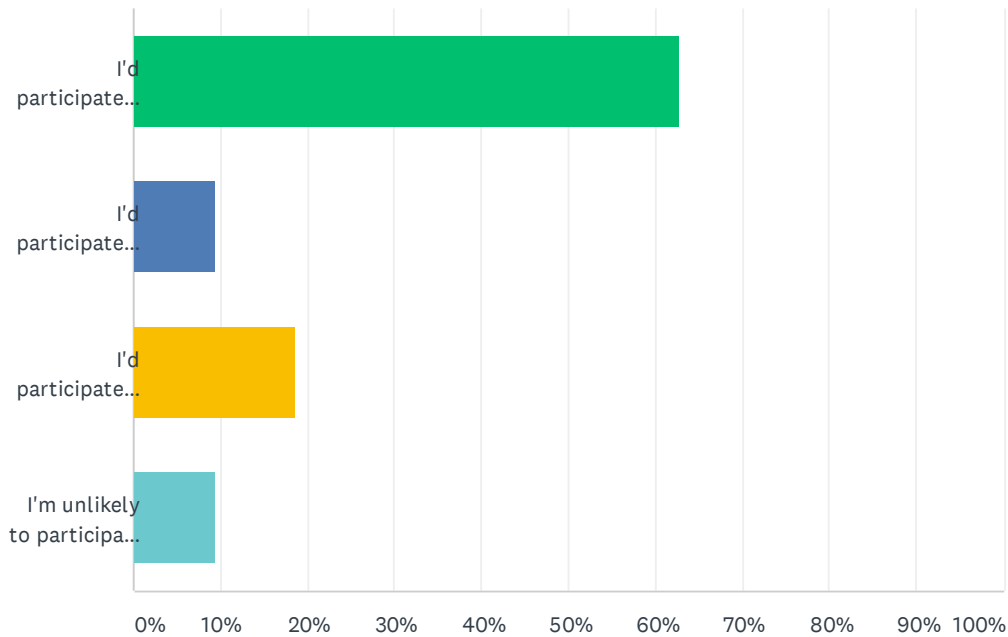

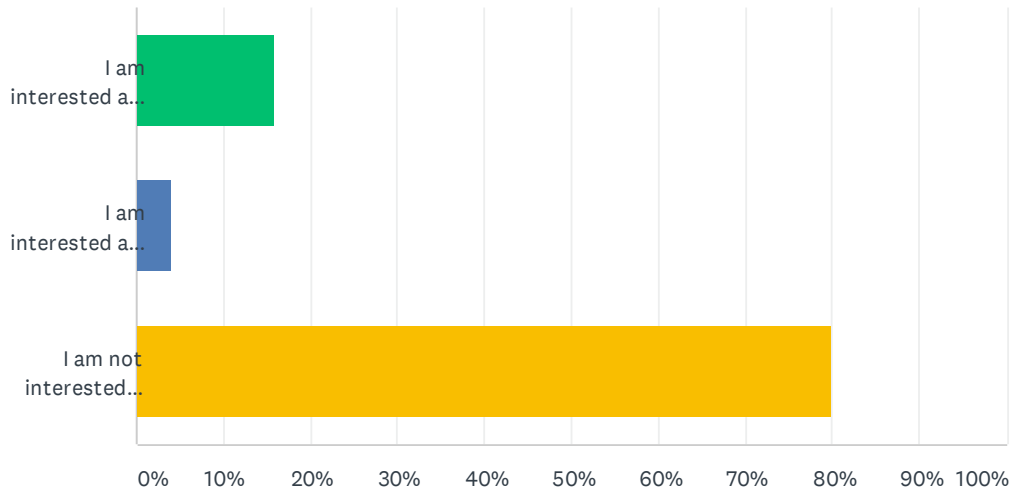

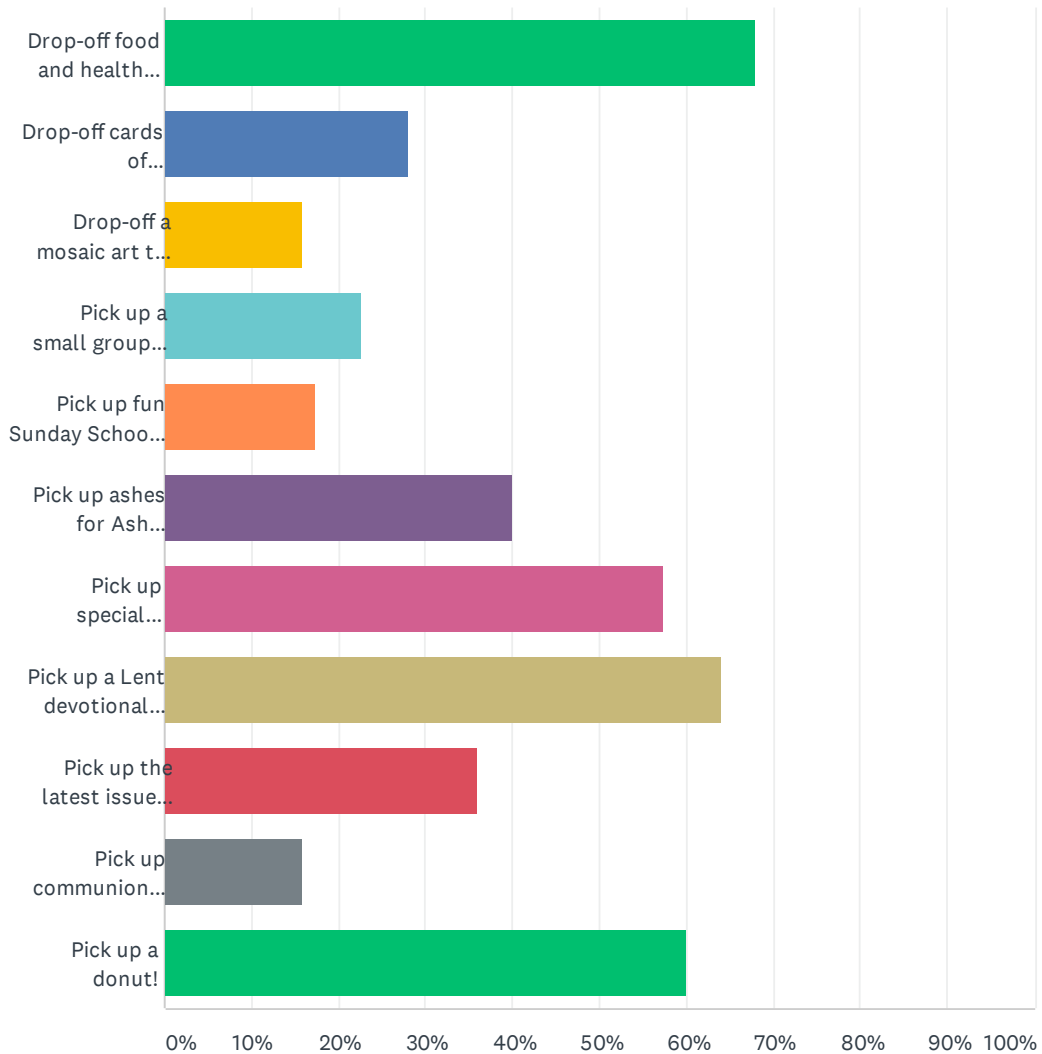

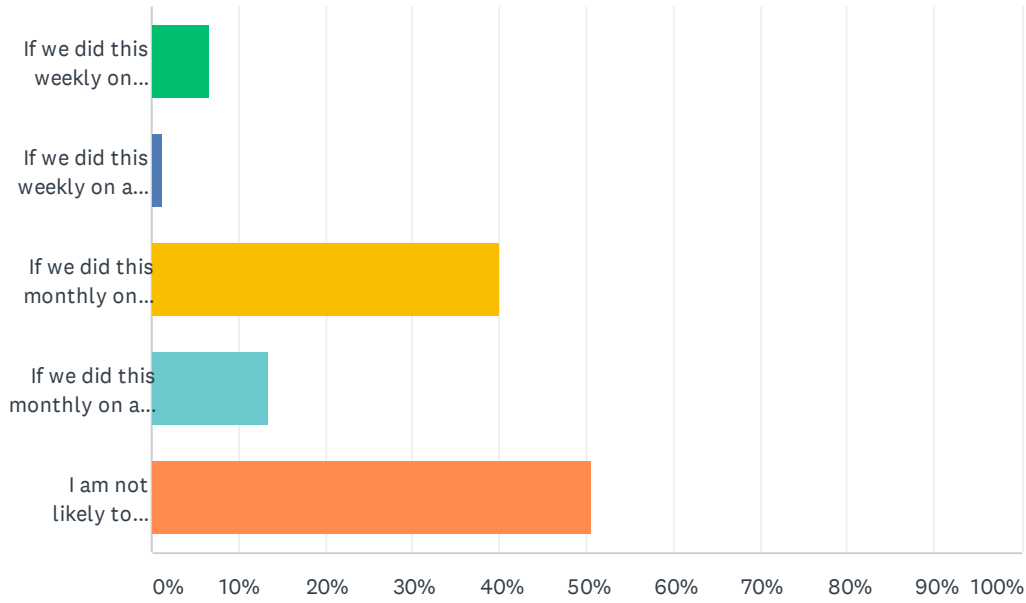

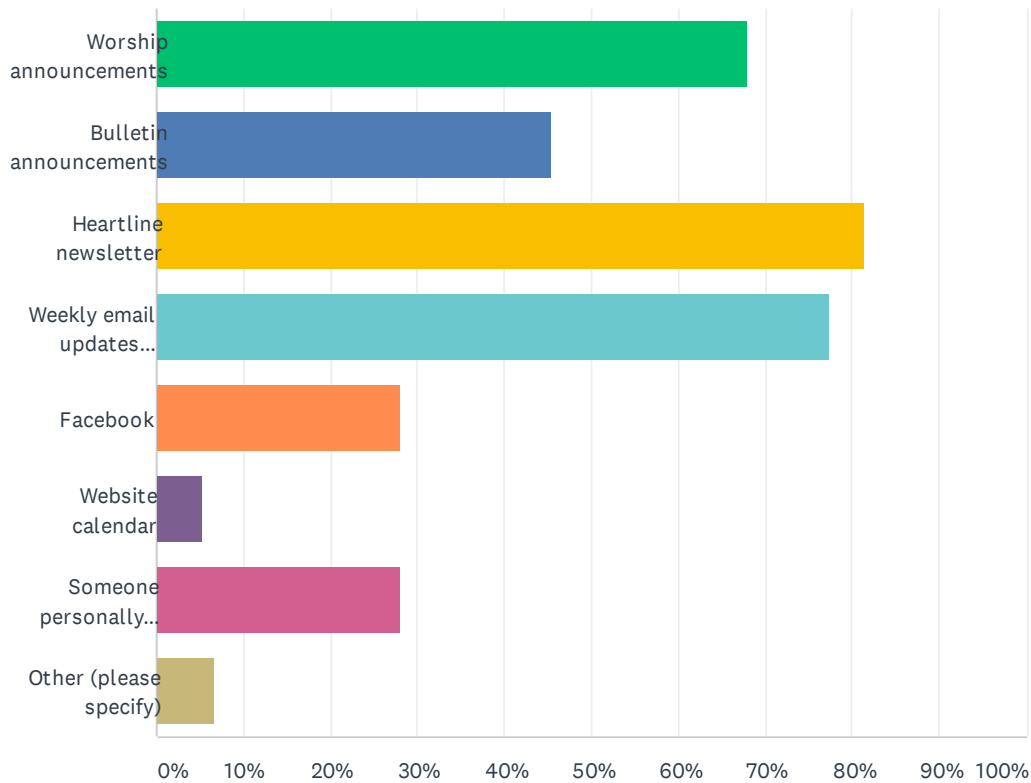

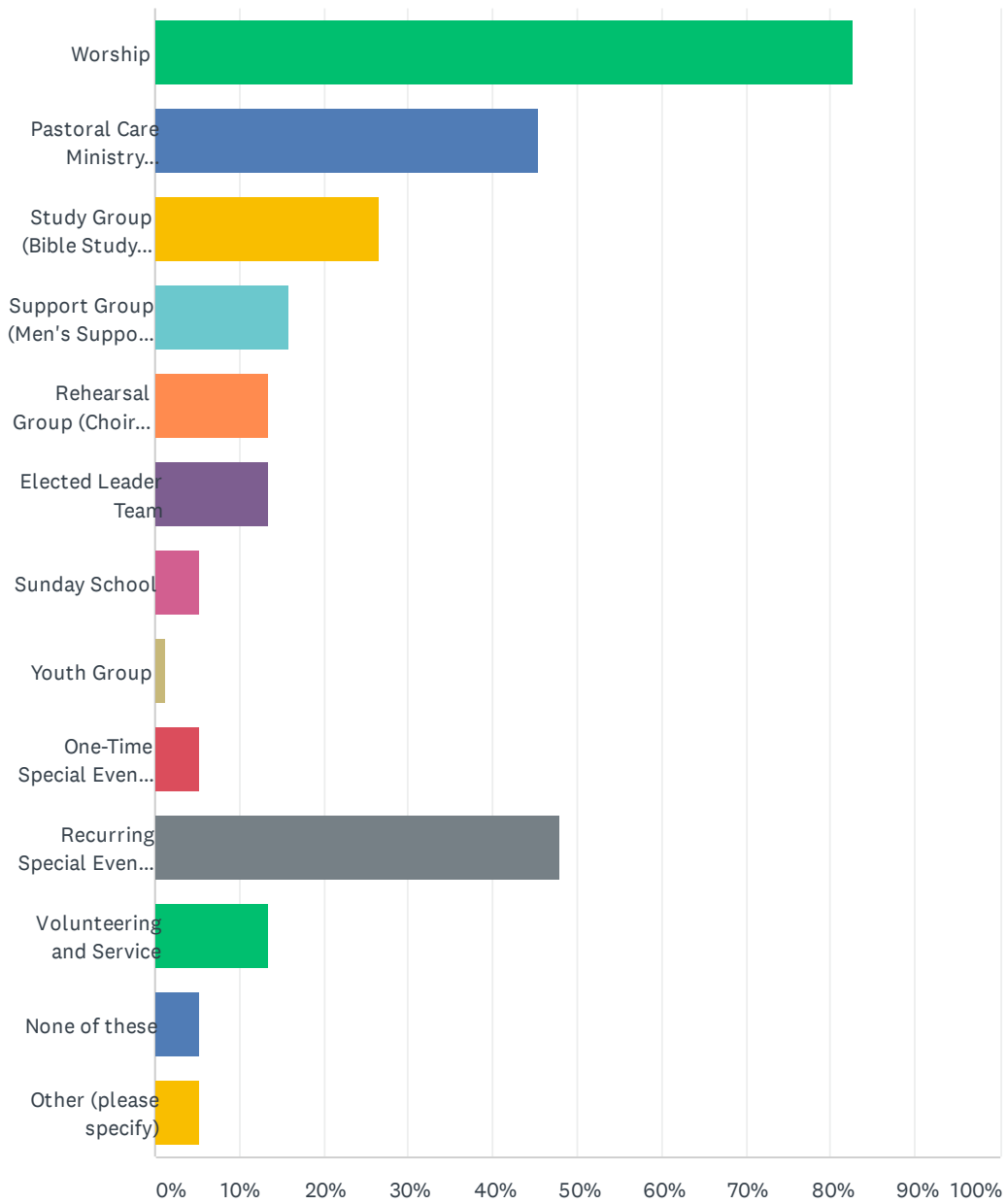

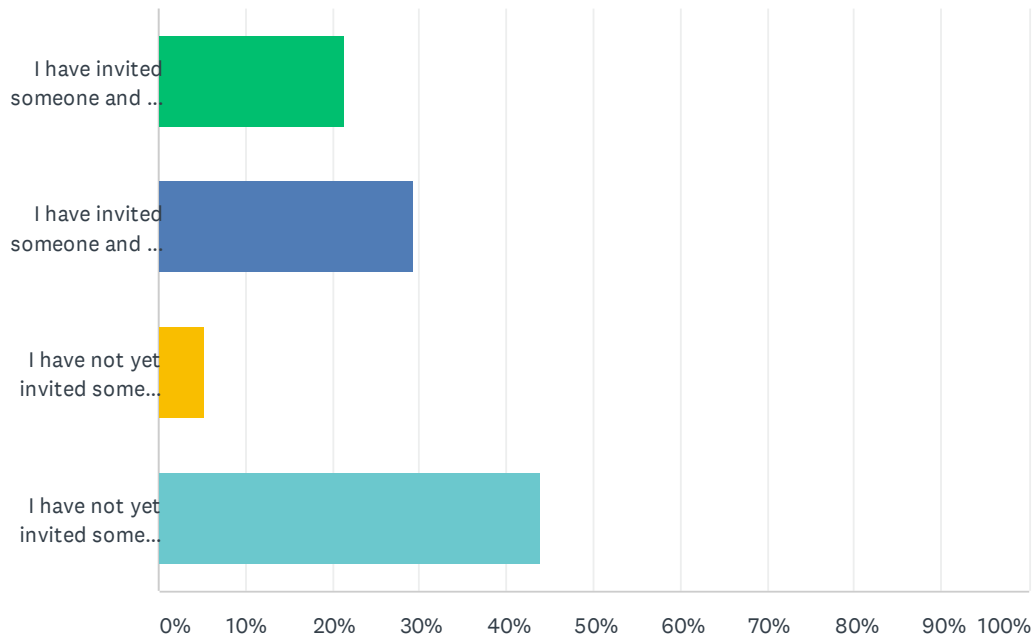
